Get to know Judy Wu - Senior Director, Program and Development for JA China and a JA Alumna



Judy Wu, Senior Director, Program and Development for JA China

1. **JA AP:** Describe your first entrepreneurial experience with JA China

Judy: My classmates introduced me to the JA MESE program and I joined the program in my sophomore year at the East China Normal University in May 2006. The team was divided into 5 groups in the program and each group was operating as a mini-company producing and selling the product "Echo Pen" at the time. Through market simulation and competition strategy, our mini company has won with the biggest market share in the end.

Although my major in school was international economics and trading, the JA program experience was my very first time to learn how the market works in real life. It taught me how to develop and adjust longer term company strategy. More importantly, I have

learned the spirit of teamwork and entrepreneurship.

2. **JA AP:** What was your journey like to get to where you are as the Senior Director, Program and Development for JA China

Judy: I became a JA volunteer after finished the MESE program, and taught Our World program in Shanghai to primary school students. Since then, I have worked for JA and other MNCs as interns throughout the course of my years in school. I have then decided to join JA fulltime after graduation, despite of other offers from Banks and MNCs. People around me were skeptical on what JA is all about and how I could make a living working in the non-profit sector. What even shocked them more is that I have been working in JA for 11 years since then, developing a career with life-long connections whilst helping to develop youth in China for a better future at the same time!

In my early years with JA, I was in charge of different programs targeting students from primary to university years. In 2011, I had the chance to pick up fundraising and Public Relations work. With the different roles and challenges, I was never bored and had many opportunities to grow at JA. The diverse and global network of JA has provided employees opportunities to network with like-minded volunteers, mentors, and colleagues around the globe; and they have become an eminent part of my JA journey, as much as inspiring me every step of the way.

3. **JA AP:** Describe what you have done to achieve a personal goal.

Judy: I strive on challenges and is always curious and keen to learn new things. I have left comfort zones to take on challenges and bigger responsibility.

4. **JA AP:** What is your aspiration for JA China?

Judy: The best partner with the business and education sectors to deliver innovative business and economics programs in China.

5. **JA AP:** What three words would you use to describe yourself?

Judy: Conscientious, passionate, developer

The Chairman Visits in Indonesia

Prestasi Junior Indonesia (PJI) has successfully undertaken the rejuvenation of Taman Mataram and converted it to a public space which has a financial literacy theme – the first of its kind in Indonesia. The efforts resulted in the winning of the Prudential plc Chairman's Challenge Innovation Award 2016. PJI, together with the team from Prudential Indonesia, received this award for the second year in a row, which includes a grant of £10,000.

Over a period of five weeks, several hundred of Prudential Volunteers worked with PJI and the Faculty of Landscape Design at Trisakti University on converting a relatively benign park seldom used by the local population into a special green space with a financial literacy theme.

In celebration of this success, Mr. Paul Manduca, the Prudential plc Chairman and Mr. Sean Rach, Chief Marketing officer, Prudential Corporation Asia, visited the Park on March 30, 2017, to meet students and inspected the financial literacy innovations which have been integrated into the design to promote improved financial awareness.

Having participated in the Prudential Chairman's award over a period of ten years, PJI was excited to have the opportunity to present to the Chairman himself, the work undertaken within the Jakarta community which he promotes.

Economics and Tourism Brain Ring Competition



Economics and Tourism Brain Ring Competition is an original intellectual quiz game used as a monitoring and stimulation tool for students who learn economics and tourism. This game reveals the knowledge and skills obtained by students studying JA Economics and other business and tourism programs. In November 2016, USAID JA Project in Turkmenistan and the Union of Economists of Turkmenistan conducted the Economics and Tourism Brain Ring competition for 97 young men and women. The students were grouped in 20 teams representing 18 education institutions and training centers across Turkmenistan.

Based on the JA Job Shadow Program, My Career Program includes in-class theoretical activities, a visit to business enterprises in Turkmenistan, where the youth gets a unique possibility to take an up-close look at the world of work and business. The program is designed to motivate an interest in learning through helping young people to understand how the things they study at school can be applied to their further work and career prospects. In 2016, twenty-eight young men and women participated in the program conducted by USAID JA Worldwide Project in Turkmenistan and the Union of Economists of Turkmenistan with support of 20 business enterprises of Turkmenistan from a wide spectrum of private businesses and industries.
